Questions You Can Ask

Past:

What were you involved in in high school?

What is your family like?

What are your highlights, hard times, heroes?

College:

What are you looking for in your freshman experience?

What do you know/ think about Cru? What are you wanting to get involved in this semester?

What are your fears about college?

How did you hear about Cru/converge/family time?

How has your experience been since coming to Texas State?

What has been hard?

Have you made any good friendships since being here?

How long have you been involved in Cru?

Spiritual Background:

What made you want to(come to or stick around) Cru?

Did your family go to church growing up?

Was church or God part of your life growing up? What did that look like for you?

What has your experience with religion been?

Is your religion based on what your parents believe or have you taken it as your own?

If God could change one area of who you are, what would you want it to be?

If they have a church background: When did your faith become your own?

How would you describe who God is?

Next Steps:

How could I or CRU help you know God better this year?
